## Accidental Heart



In January of 2013, I was attempting the pattern for "Priscilla Yoke Ear Rings" provided by Elain Gan on her blog: http://tattingpatterns.blogspot.com/ when I was distracted by conversation and accidentally connected a ring into the wrong location. Since I didn't realize my mistake until I was ready to connect the next ring, I decided to keep it and mirror it on the other side. The result was a heart shape I like quite a bit. Ring 1: 7-3-4
Ring 2: 4+6-6-4
Ring 3: 4+3-7
Chain: 2-2-2-2-2-2 (5 picots)
Ring: $6+$ (to 1st picot of Ring 1) 6
Chain: 2-2-2-2-2-2 (5 picots)
Ring: 6 + (to 1st picot of Ring 1 - same as
the last join) 6
Chain: 2-2-2-2-2-2 (5 picots)
Ring: $6+$ (to joined picot of Ring 1 \& 2) 6
Chain: 2-2-2-2-2-2 (5 picots)
Ring: $6+$ (to middle picot of Ring 2) 6
Chain: 3-2-3
Shoelace trick
Ring: 3-2-2-2-2-3 (5 picots)
Shoelace trick
Chain 3-2-3
Ring $6+$ (to middle picot of Ring 2) 6
Chain 2-2-2-2-2-2 (5 picots)
Ring $6+$ (to joined picot of Ring 2 \& 3) 6


Chain 2-2-2-2-2-2 (5 picots)
Ring $6+$ (to 2nd picot of Ring 3 ) 6
Chain 2-2-2-2-2-2 (5 picots)
Ring $6+$ (to 2 nd picot of Ring 3 - same as the last join) 6
Chain 2-2-2-2-2-2 (5 picots)
